Jacek's sculptures range from large scale, outdoor pieces to smaller, intimate works. They reflect his passion for exploring how the external forms of small sea creatures are dictated by their complex internal structures and how they reflect the tension generated by their interaction with, often violent, environmental forces.

His fascination with the marine environment is also reflected in Jacek's paintings, inspired by the dynamic flow and clash of oceanic currents and environmental forces and the resulting geographic features – archipelagos, island arcs, seaweed forests, deep-water hydrothermals and coastal landforms.

In this show, Jacek's sculptures and paintings will be exhibited together for the first time, offering a new perspective on the underwater world and a chance for gallery visitors to immerse themselves in it.
