Meet the artists, be entertained and mingle with the locals.

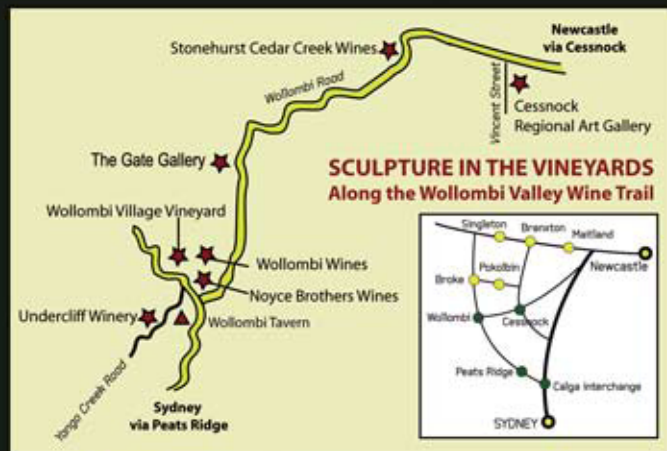
Twilight Tours - Saturday 8, 15, 22 and 29 October

While being guided through the site, guests will have the opportunity to hear dreaming stories & to ask questions about the history of Aboriginal people in the Wollombi Valley finishing the evening with wine & cheese as the sun sets over glorious Mt Yengo.
